

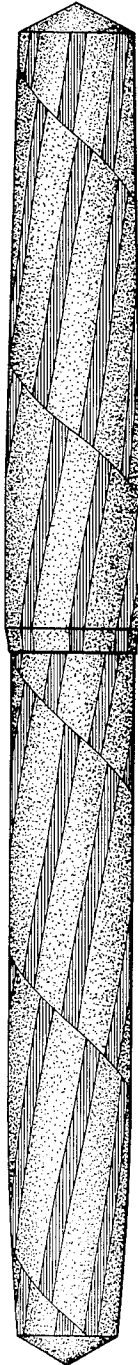

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN OR SIMILAR

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Robert Back, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein the figure is an elevational view of a fountain pen or similar article showing my new design.

The different types of surface shading on the drawing are intended to represent areas of con-

trasting colors. The characterizing features of the design reside in the arrangement of contiguous helices having alternate stripes of contrasting colors extending transversely of the helices and obliquely of the axis of the pen barrel in the spiral direction opposite that of the helices, the ends of corresponding stripes on the contiguous helices being in offset relationship.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a fountain pen or similar article substantially as shown and described.
