To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Lynn P. Martin, a citizen of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Figure 1.

The dominant feature of my design resides in the contour of the clip shown in full lines.
