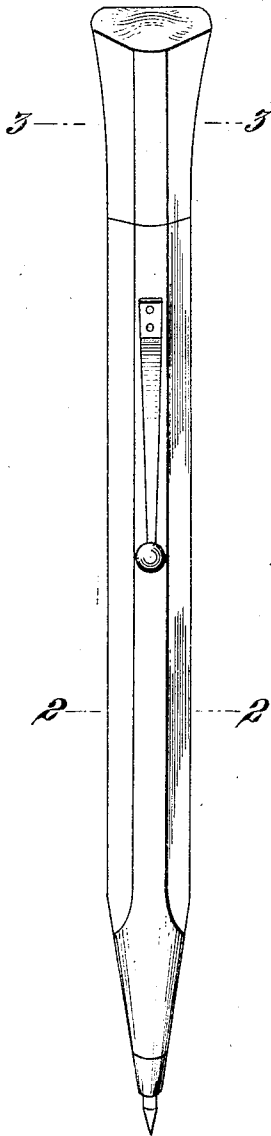

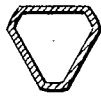
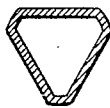

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL

Application filed October 1, 1929. Serial No. 32,905. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known, that I, GEORGE COBY, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Cranston, county of Providence, State of Rhode Island, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Pencil, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view; Fig. 2 is a sec-

tional view on line 2—2 of Fig. 1, showing the triangular shape of the body of the pencil; and Fig. 3 is a section on line 3—3 of Fig. 1, showing the triangular shape of the head of the pencil, showing my new design.
