To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Alfonso Iannelli, a citizen of the United States, residing at Park Ridge, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Eraser Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, wherein

Fig. 1 is an elevational view of an eraser holder embodying my new design, and showing in dotted lines an eraser therein, for the purpose of making clear the character of the device; and Fig. 2 is an end elevational view of said eraser holder, looking at the upper end of Fig. 1.

The stippling on certain areas of the figures is used for the purpose of indicating that those areas are of a color contrasting with the areas which are not stippled.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an eraser holder, substantially as shown and described.
