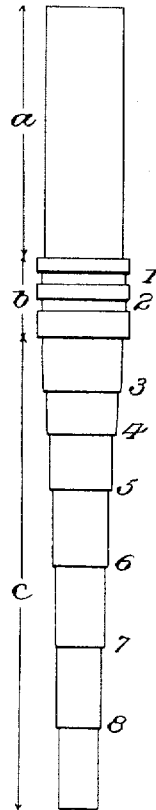

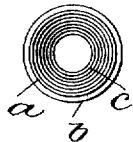
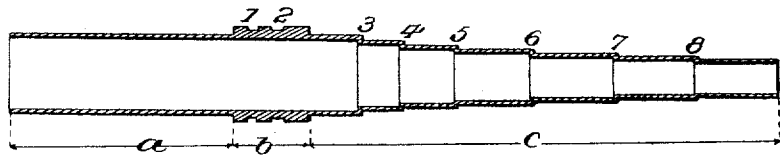

DESIGN FOR A PENCIL-CASE BARREL.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 28,838, dated June 14, 1898.

Application filed April 29, 1898. Serial No. 679,246. Term of patent 3½ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, LE ROY C. FAIRCHILD, a citizen of the United States of America, and a resident of the borough of Manhattan, in the city of New York and State of New York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Pencil-Case Barrel, of which the following is a specification.

A sheet of drawings accompanies this specification as part thereof.

Figure 1 of the drawings is a side elevation of the barrel of a pencil-case, showing my new design. Fig. 2 is an end view of said barrel, and Fig. 3 represents a central longitudinal section of the same.

This design relates to the "barrel" of a pencil-case, and its leading characteristic is an external shape or configuration suggestive in appearance of a jacketed cannon unmounted, together with the internal-stepped configuration shown in the drawings.

In the drawings, *a* represents a cylindrical portion, *b* a circumferential banded portion with interspaces or grooves 1 and 2, and *c* a stepped portion composed of successive cylindrical lengths of gradually-diminishing circumference concentric with said portions *a* and *b* and connected with each other by shoulders or steps 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8.

The interior of the barrel has steps or shoulders corresponding with said steps or shoulders 3 to 8, inclusive, as shown in Figs. 2 and 3.

Having thus described said design, I claim as new and original and desire to patent under this specification—

The design for a pencil-case barrel, substantially as shown and described.
