

DESIGN FOR A FOUNTAIN PEN

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, Ned D. Fish and Max Oehler, citizens of the United States, residing at Fort Madison, in the county of Lee and State of Iowa, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Fountain Pen, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a fountain pen showing our new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view of Fig. 1; and Fig. 3 is a sectional view of the clip only and taken on line **3—3** of Fig. 1.

The dominant feature of our design resides in the contour and ornamental appearance of the clip member shown in full lines.

We claim:
